- ADOT list: (41) projects, totaling \$354.2M (highway new capacity and highway system preservation)
- Local STP list: (89) projects from nine MPOs, totaling \$154M (majority highway system preservation)
- TE list: (30) projects from nine MPOs, totaling \$17.6M (majority non-motorized transportation)

Notable projects

Highway New Capacity

- U.S. 60/Grand Avenue in Maricopa County, \$45.0M – 10 miles of widening
- I-10: Sarival Avenue to Verrado Way in Maricopa County, \$43.2M – construct one general purpose lane in each direction
- I-10: Picacho Peak - Town of Picacho, \$30M – roadway widening
- I-17: Carefree Highway to Anthem Way in Maricopa County, \$22.5M – construct one general purpose lane in each direction

Complete Streets

- Scottsdale Road, Scottsdale, \$4.6M to install new bike lanes and enhanced pedestrian facilities, transit shelters and streetscape
- Beardsley Road, Peoria, \$1.1M – overlay and restriping to five lanes plus bike lanes
- Shea Blvd, Fountain Hills, \$1.1M – widening project for 3rd lane includes bike lane and sidewalk
- Charleston Road widening, City of Sierra Vista, \$2.2M – includes sidewalk and multiuse path

Other

- Marsh Station Traffic Interchange Reconstruction, Pima County, \$18M – remove existing railroad and bridge, reconstruct main line
- ADA ramps for Phoenix, \$3.5M – remove/replace existing and construction of new ADA ramps

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
