

CALPIRG's mission is to deliver persistent, result-oriented public interest activism that protects consumers, encourages a fair, sustainable economy, and fosters responsive, democratic government.

Our 2013 scorecard grades legislators for their votes on CALPIRG-supported legislation to protect consumers, lower health care costs, foster participation in elections, reduce the influence of big money in politics, and make tax subsidies more transparent and accountable. Members of the Senate are scored on up to 19 votes, and members of the Assembly on up to 15 votes. The total number of bills per legislator varies because not every bill received a floor vote.

CONSUMER PROTECTION

SB 272 (Corbett): Prohibits misleading advertisements that falsely imply a connection, approval or endorsement of products, goods or services by a military veteran or military veteran service organization. The bill was signed into law.

VOTE DESCRIPTIONS

SB 383 (Jackson): Would restore strong privacy protections for online credit card transactions The bill is pending.

SB 418 (Jackson): Would have protected electricity ratepayers by allowing the Public Utilities Commission to access and properly consider future costs for ratepayers if California's nuclear plants were to receive a license extension. The bill did not pass.

SB 686 (Jackson): Would prohibit auto dealers from selling recalled vehicles that are unsafe and unrepaired to consumers. The bill is pending.

AB 25 (Campos): Prevents public sector employers from requiring or requesting an employee, or a prospective employee, to disclose the user name or account password for a personal social media account. The bill was signed into law.

AB 370 (Muratsuchi): Requires an operator of a commercial internet website to disclose whether or not it honors "do not track" requests by consumers. The bil was signed into law.

AB 1162 (Frazier): Would have provided students increased consumer protections for banking services offered on campus. The bill did not pass.

AB1220(Skinner): Allows consumers to receive the same information in their credit reports that lenders, potential landlords and other users can access about them, so that consumers can better identify and correct errors. The bill was signed into law.

HEALTH CARE

SBX 1-2 (Hernandez): Prevents health insurance companies from discriminating against individuals, and implements other consumer protections in line with the Affordable Care Act The bill was signed into law.

SB 639 (Hernandez): Establishes caps for deductibles and total out-of-pocket costs for all health insurance plans. The bill was signed into law.

SB 746 (Leno): Would have required health insurance companies to disclose the justification for the rates they set for employer-based health care coverage. The bill was vetoed by the governor.

DEMOCRACY

SB 29 (Correa): Would prevent the disenfranchisement of voters by allowing mail-in ballots to count if they are postmarked by Election Day. The bill is pending.

SB 44 (Yee): Requires the homepage of every state website to provide a link to online voter registration. The bill was signed into law.

SB 361 (Padilla): Would give California colleges, state agencies and the DMV better tools and guidelines for helping the people they interact with to register to vote or update their voter registration. The bill is pending.

MONEY IN POLITICS

SB 2 (Lieu): Would require increased disclosure of the funders behind political campaigns, including requiring TV ads for statewide campaigns to include a "Stand By Your Ad" provision. The bill is pending.

SB 3 (Yee): Would have laid the groundwork for an electronic filing database to enable voters to more easily track the lobbying and campaign contributions of special interests. The bill was vetoed by the governor.

SB 52 (Leno): Would require the three largest

funders of political advertisements to be clearly identified to viewers for television, radio, print and online ads. The bill is pending.

SB 121 (Evans): Would have required corpora-

tions to inform shareholders about their political campaign spending. The bill did not pass.
