## Bill Summaries

### 1. Building Energy Efficiency: HB 1622

HB 1622 increases the energy efficiency of buildings in the state.

Pro-Environment Vote: **YES**

Outcome: Passed, Signed by Governor

### 2. Banning Invasive Atlantic Salmon: HB 2957

HB 2957 effectively bans the practice of open-water Atlantic salmon aquaculture in the state of Washington.

Pro-Environment Vote: **YES**

Outcome: Passed, Signed by Governor

### 3. Healthy Food Packaging: HB 2658

HB 2658 bans the use of PFAS (per and polyfluoralkyl substances) chemicals in food packaging.

Pro-Environment Vote: **YES**

Outcome: Passed, Signed by Governor

### 4. Oil Transportation Safety: SB 6269

SB 6269 strengthens oil transportation safety by providing reliable funding for state oil spill prevention work.

Pro-Environment Vote: **YES**

Outcome: Passed, Signed by Governor

### 5. Toxic Chemicals in Firefighting Foam: SB 6413

SB 6413 bans the use of PFAS (per and polyfluoralkyl substances) chemicals in food packaging.

Pro-Environment Vote: **YES**

Outcome: Passed, Signed by Governor

### 6. Orca Protection Act: SB 5886

SB 5886 strengthens enforcement against harassment and noise pollution to protect orcas.

Pro-Environment Vote: **YES**

Outcome: Senate Passed

### 7. Appliance Efficiency Standards: HB 2327

HB 2327 establishes minimum energy and water standards for products that residents and workers use every day.

Pro-Environment Vote: **YES**

Outcome: House Passed

### 8. Electric Vehicles: HB 2653

HB 2653 expands incentives for electric vehicles.

Pro-Environment Vote: **YES**

Outcome: House Passed

### 9. Nonnative finfish: SB 6086

SB 6086 protects the state's marine waters from the release of nonnative finfish from marine finfish aquaculture sites.

Pro-Environment Vote: **YES**

Outcome: Senate Passed
