


## SUMMER FUN INDEX

Number of national parks with a waterway <sup>1</sup>	14

Number of state parks with a waterway <sup>3</sup>	51
Visitors to state parks with waterways <sup>4</sup>	1.2 million
Number of summer camps offering water activities <sup>5</sup>	97
Number of registered boats <sup>6</sup>	826,596
Number of fishing licenses, tags, and permits <sup>7</sup>	2.6 million
Number of fishing licenses <sup>8</sup>	1.6 million
