EV Charging

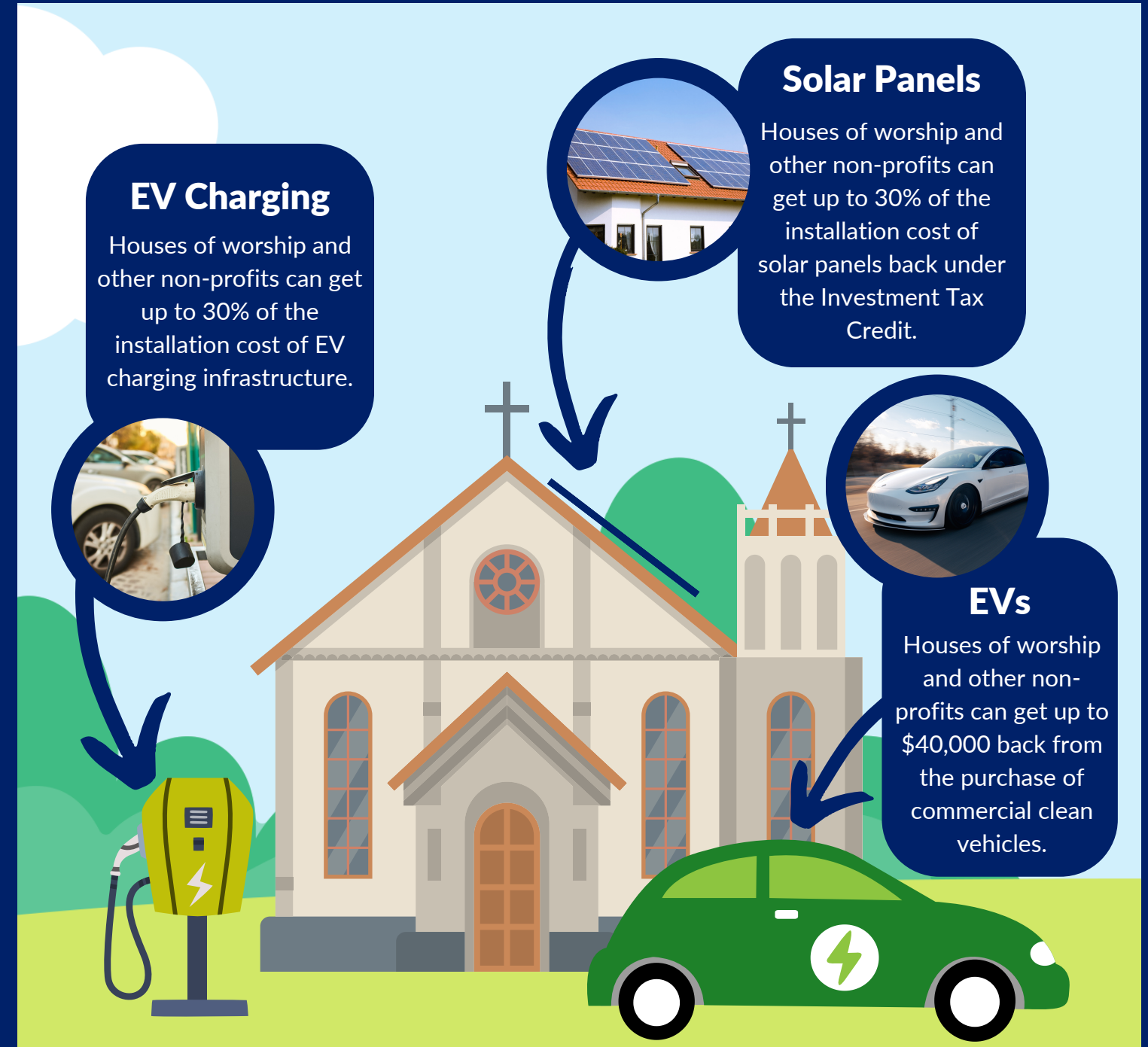
Houses of worship and other non-profits can get up to 30% of the installation cost of EV charging infrastructure.

Solar Panels

Houses of worship and other non-profits can get up to 30% of the installation cost of solar panels back under the Investment Tax Credit.

EVs

Houses of worship and other non-profits can get up to \$40,000 back from the purchase of commercial clean vehicles.
